In these days The Vienna Vegetable Orchestra celebrates its 15th anniversary. In addition to performing on the international concert circuit, the 10-people collective from Vienna has spent the last dozen years experimenting with the building of vegetable instruments, industriously unearthing the acoustic universe of roots and legumes, cabbages and courgettes. All the instruments used are exclusively made from vegetables: from fresh as well as dried plant material such as carrot, leek, celery root, artichoke, dried pumpkin and onion skin.

The sounds produced by the vegetable instruments are amazingly multi-layered. Stylistically the music oscillates between organic pop music and aural sound experiments, with inspiration from various sources. Invitations to renowned festivals such as Sonár in Barcelona or to Huddersfield seem an obvious consequence.



Onionoise, their third album in 11 years, bares the fruits of that search with every crackle, gurgle, honk, squawk, tweet, bleat, thump and bump of countless combinations and servings of one of the world's greatest food groups.
